

2025 PERSONNEL AND VEHICLE PASSES

The Department for Enterprise as Promoter of the Classic TT Races and the Manx Motorcycle Club as the Promoter of the Manx Grand Prix Races (together known as the 'Promoters') and ACU Events Ltd (the 'Race Organiser') issue passes to competitors, officials, guests and contractors in order to manage the number of people in restricted areas.

There has been a review of the pass system for Manx Grand Prix ('MGP') and Classic TT ('CTT') 2025 and it is important you note the changes laid out in this document.

GENERAL RULES

1. Teams and competitors are responsible for the integrity of the pass system within their team. Sanctions will be imposed on any team whose members abuse the pass system in any way including, but not limited to:
 - 1.1. Selling passes
 - 1.2. Production, sale or distribution of forged passes
 - 1.3. Obtaining passes for individuals outside of team personnel and sponsors
 - 1.4. Lending passes
2. All pass holders must accept the instruction of the security team on site. Any queries with regards to access must be logged with the Race Office to be raised with the security team. Any pass holder reported to be abusive towards or ignoring the direction of a member of the security team will have their pass revoked immediately.
3. Teams and competitors must keep accurate records of the numbers of passes that they issue to any guests; this information must be available for audit if requested by the Promoters and the Race Organisers.
4. Teams and competitors who provide a pass to a guest must ensure they are advised of the expected behaviour, which includes but is not limited to:
 - 4.1. Be aware of moving motorcycles
 - 4.2. Respecting the instruction of any official or security officer
 - 4.3. No consumption of alcohol in restricted areas
5. Anyone found in a restricted area with a forged or duplicated pass will be treated as having entered close roads without authorisation and may be prosecuted.

ISSUING PASSES

6. A set number of passes will be issued with each competitors signing on pack, this will constitute:
 - 6.1. 6x Team Passes
 - 6.2. 4x Pit Lane Attendant passes
 - 6.3. 2x Startline Passes

Team Passes are to be allocated to mechanics and those required on the grid to remove tyre warmers etc. These passes are limited to 6 (six) per competitor unless reasonable circumstances are provided and approved. If a competitor is competing for more than one team across multiple classes, additional passes will be included in the pack the competitor receives at signing on.

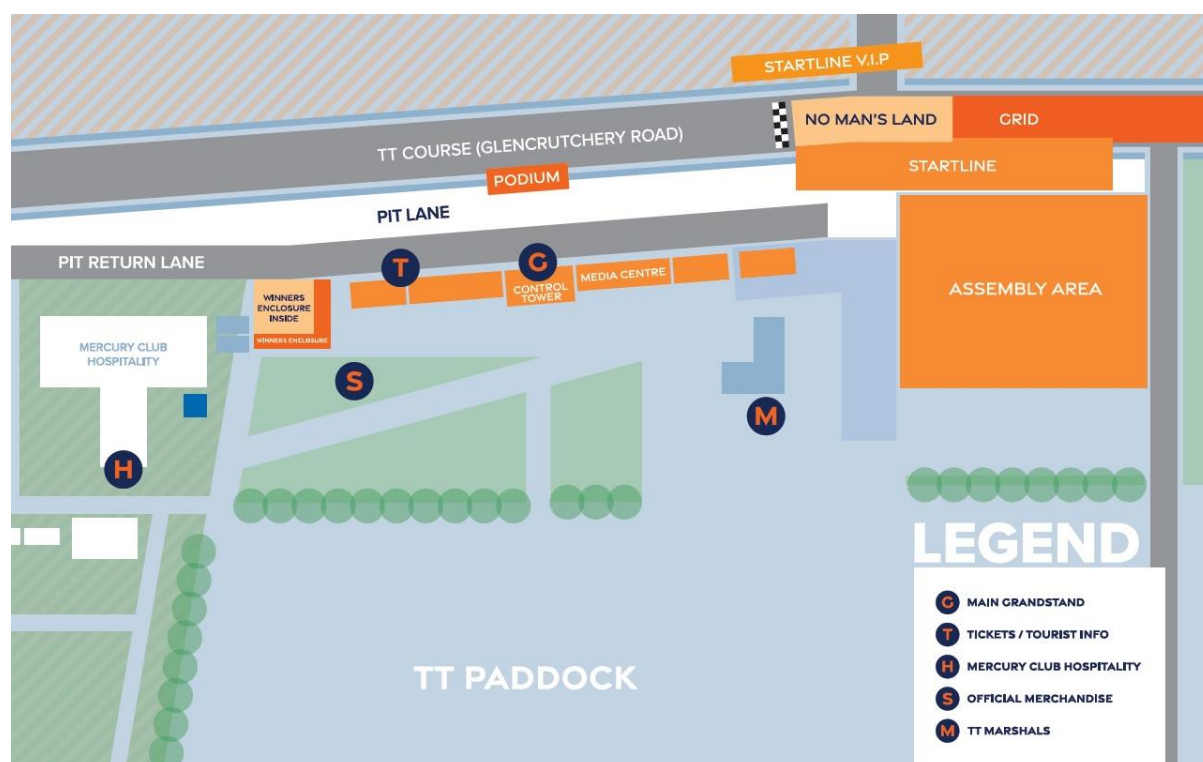
Guest passes provide the same access as a Team pass, but do not require a photo. Guests passes may be used for close family members or major sponsors. Holders of Guest passes will be required to vacate the grid at the 7-minute signal.

7. Additional passes may be purchased for £10 per pass from the Race Office. The passes available to purchase are:
 - 7.1. Guest Pass (limited to 5 additional passes per rider)
 - 7.2. Startline Pass (limited to 10 additional passes per rider)

The Startline Pass provides access only to the Startline area as defined on the below map. These may be issued to family, friends or sponsors who do not need to be in the 'Grid' or 'Assembly' areas.

8. All passes are numbered and recorded when issued. All competitors will be limited to the quantities listed above unless reasonable circumstances are provided and approved.
9. Each request must be made by the competitor named on the form. No passes will be issued to individuals submitting requests 'on behalf of' any competitors.
10. No passes may be requested from the Promoters Office.
11. By requesting your passes in advance of the event, if approved, this will reduce the administration time on event and speed up the request process.

GRANDSTAND AREA LAYOUT

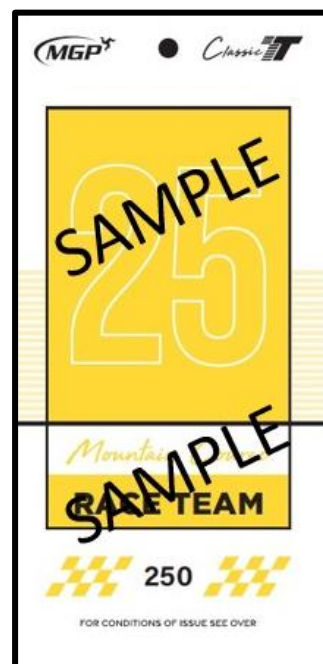


PERSONNEL PASS BREAKDOWN

12. There are different types of personnel passes depending on the activity of the pass holder, providing various levels of access around the TT Grandstand site. The individual personnel passes, the descriptions of their intended usage and details of the access they provide is detailed below and on the reverse of the pass.
13. Personnel passes only permit access to the areas defined in these regulations and on the rear of the pass, as defined in the map below.

RACE TEAM

- The Race Team passes are issued to competitors at signing on. They are to be distributed to their team and are to be used by those carrying out a bona fide operational role within a team only.
- Sequentially numbered, the passes require the holder to include a passport photo of themselves
- The Race Team Pass provide access to the Pit Return Lane and the Winners Enclosure.
- The Race Organiser will provide an extra set of passes to competitors who are competing for more than one team. These will be provided to the competitor at signing on



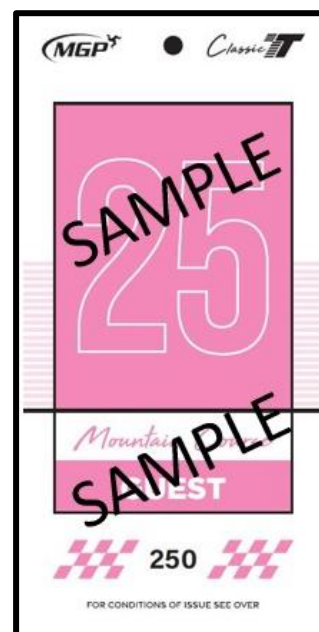
STARTLINE

- The Startline pass is issued to guests of teams, the Race Organisers and Promoters, and provides access to the start line only, as depicted on the map.
- The accessible area is between the wall of the Assembly Area and the temporary barrier which borders the Grid.
- This access can only be used in the period preceding a qualifying session or race and holders of such a pass will be required to vacate the area once all the machines have left the start line, or as instructed to do so by an Official.
- Startline Guest passes are issued on an individual day basis, a Qualifying Week only pass, a Race Week long pass or an 'All Days' pass which is valid for the duration of the event



GUEST PASS

- These passes are new for TT 2025 and carry the same access permissions as a 'Race Team Pass'. This pass however cannot be used in conjunction with a Pit Lane pass or Winner Enclosure pass.
- Holders of these passes will be vacated from the Grid on the sounding of the 7-minute signal.
- Passes may be used by competitors and teams who wish to provide close family or sponsors access to the Assembly Area or Grid.



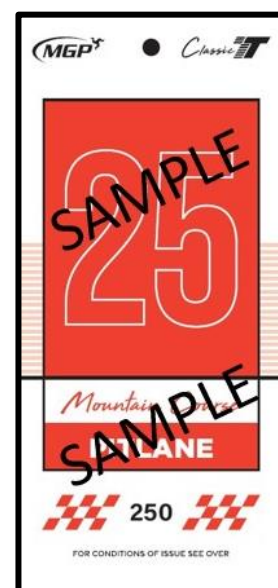
COMPETITOR WRISTBAND

- Each competitor will be issued with a wristband which will provide them with the same access granted under a 'Race Team' pass.
- The wristbands will be sequentially numbered



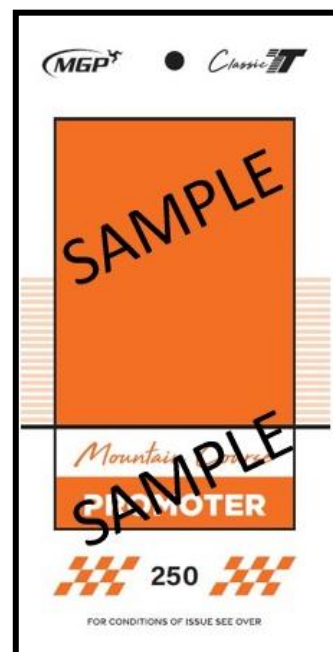
PIT LANE ATTENDANT

- The Pit Attendant pass is issued to teams and competitors at signing on providing access for no more than 4 persons per rider into the pit lane for pit stop duties during the races.
- The Pit Attendant pass must be worn in conjunction with a Race Team Pass. Individuals attempting to access the pit lane without both passes being worn will be refused entry
- Additional passes may be requested from the Race Office for riders in more than one team. No fee will be charged in this circumstance
- An extra set of passes will be provided to competitors who are competing for more than one team. These will be provided to the competitor at signing on



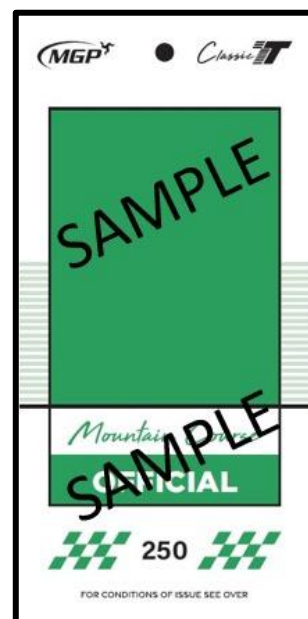
PROMOTER

- The Promoter pass is issued to those working for the Promoter team and allow access to all areas of the TT Grandstand and Paddock Site.
- These passes are issued by the Department for Enterprise Motorsport Team only, are sequentially numbered and require the pass holder to include a photo of themselves for display on the pass.
- The Promoter pass does not entitle the holder to a seat in the Grandstand, VIP Hospitality catering or access to on-course Prohibited, Restricted or Hazardous areas.



OFFICIAL

- The Official pass is issued to officials working on behalf of the Race Organisers.
- These passes are issued by ACU Events Ltd only, are sequentially numbered and require the pass holder to include a photo of themselves for display on the pass.
- Where required, holders of an Official pass are required to attend a pre event briefing by the Clerk of the Course and “sign on” in the Race Office before the pass is issued.



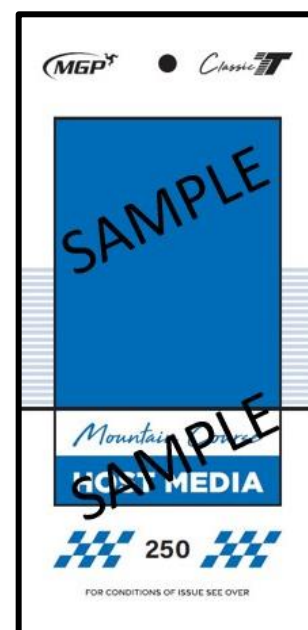
MEDIC

- The Medic pass is issued to medical team personnel and is only issued by the Medical Service contractor as appointed by the Race Organiser.
- A Medic is permitted to access a Prohibited and/or Hazardous Areas on the TT course ONLY in the event of an incident or a life threatening situation. The pass holder must follow the guidance of race officials and marshals at all times.



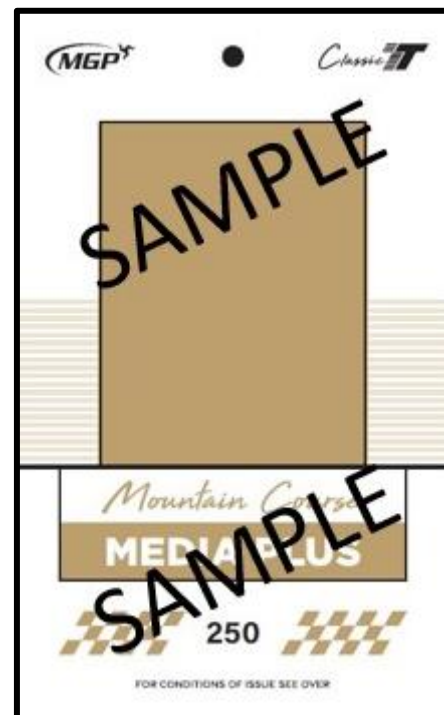
HOST MEDIA

- The Host Media pass is issued to individuals working exclusively and directly for the Promoter
- The pass must be worn in conjunction with a Host Media bib, or in the Grandstand Area, with a host media polo shirt.
- Host Media are permitted in Media Green Zones and Approved on Course Restricted Areas under the guidance and instruction of an Official or TT Marshal when wearing a Host Media tabard.
- All passes are numbered and must have a photo of the pass holder.



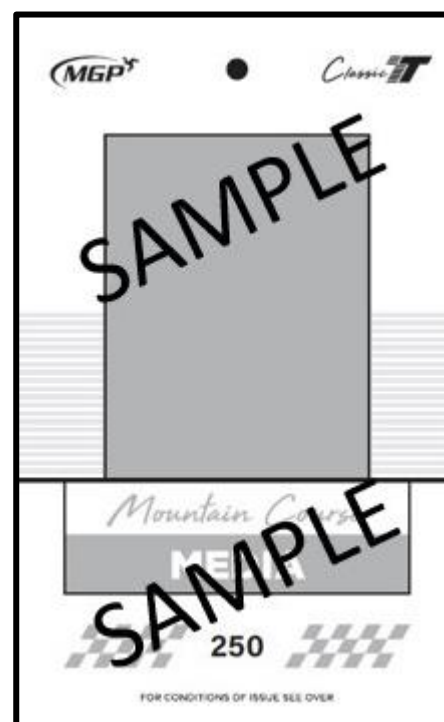
MEDIA PLUS

- The Media Plus pass is issued to individuals working in partnership with, or in the strategic interests of the Promoter.
- Media Plus pass holders must wear a Media Plus tabard at all times in restricted areas.
- All passes are numbered and must have a photo of the pass holder.



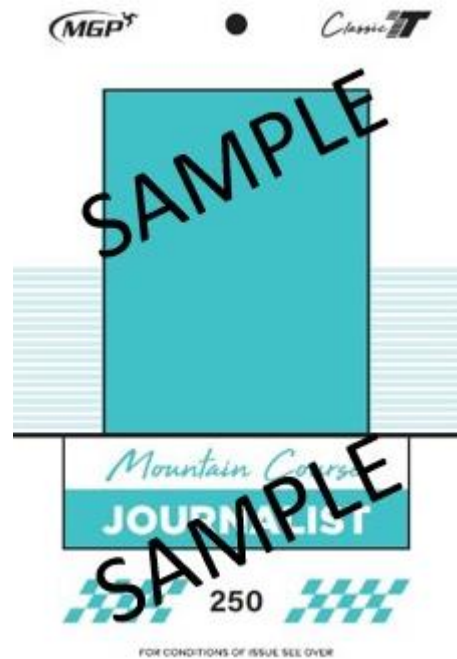
MEDIA

- The Media pass is issued to photographers, radio, TV, film and videographers who have been approved through the media accreditation channel.
- Media pass holders must wear a tabard at all times in restricted areas
- All passes are numbered and must have a photo of the pass holder.



JOURNALIST

- The Journalist pass is issued to Journalists and PR Personnel
- Journalist pass holders must clearly wear their pass at all times. There is no tabard issued to Journalist pass holders
- All passes are numbered and must have a photo of the pass holder.
