1 KEY FINDINGS

The key results from the survey are:

- Known passengers departing the Island during the interview period (with apportioned number of residents interviewed removed) were weighted by the number of interviews to estimate the overall number of visitors during that period. This was estimated to be 51,649 visitors (however, this is not the true number of visitors to the TT, but the estimated number of visitors during the interview period).
- The average expenditure per visitor was £1,015 and the total expenditure by those visitors is estimated to be £51.9 million.
- The average length of stay of all visitors was 6.54 nights and results in 336,891 bednights.
- 85.1% of visitors to the TT were staying in paid accommodation and 4.0% were on a package trip.
- 42.7% of visitors were camping, 23.9% were staying in a hotel/guesthouse/B&B and 10.1% were staying in Homestay accommodation.
- 74.4% of all visitors were from the British Islands and Ireland, 11.8% from Europe and 13.7% from the rest of the world.
- 98.0% of all visitors felt that their trip to the Isle of Man had met or exceeded their expectations.
- 46 60 years olds were the largest visiting age group comprising of 36.5% of all visitors. This was followed by 23.7% of those who were 31 45 years old. 23.2% of visitors were aged over 60 years old and 4.8% of all visitors were under the age of 16 years.

- 71.9% of all visitors also participated in an outdoor activity whilst on their visit. 20.4% of visitors had been on the Heritage Railways, 12.0% had visited family and/or friends and 2.5% had visited a Manx National Heritage site
- Only 5.4% of all visitors were registered disabled or had some form of sensory, physical or mental accessibility needs.

2 INTRODUCTION

2.1 Background

This report provides data from the Annual Isle of Man Passenger Survey 2025 covering the period 27th May to 12th June 2025 – covering visitors leaving up to during and after the end of the TT, who had responded to the question regarding 'What they had done on their visit to the Island?' – *Motorsport TT/MGP*. This period is directly comparable with the same interview periods from previous surveys. The purpose is to provide insight into the nature and economic impact of the TT Racing Event for the Motorsport Division of the Department for Enterprise. In previous years there has been a standalone survey for the period of the TT, and so this needs to be borne in mind as the results will not be directly comparable with previous surveys. It should also be noted that some questions that were asked in the standalone survey were not asked in the Isle of Man Passenger Survey.

2.2 Methodology

Face-to-face interviews were conducted in the departure lounge and vehicle loading areas at the Sea Terminal and at Ronaldsway Airport outside the departure gate. Interviews were conducted to cover the period from 27th May to 12th June 2025. Results have been weighted by known passengers departing the Island within that period, with the apportioned number of residents interviewed removed from the figure to calculate overall results.

Only passengers recorded on scheduled departures were used in the analysis for this report, it does not include unscheduled departures such as charter flights, cruise ship passengers or pleasure craft.

A copy of the questionnaire is attached in Appendix 1.

2.3 Sample size

In total, 1,184 passenger groups were interviewed during the period, which consisted of 398 groups of residents of the Isle of Man and 786 visitor groups to the Island. Of the visitor groups interviewed, 92.6% (727 groups) were visiting for the TT.

Of the passenger groups that were visiting for the TT, 261 passenger groups were interviewed at Ronaldsway Airport and 466 passenger groups interviewed at either the Sea Terminal Vehicle Loading Area or in the Sea Terminal Departure Lounge.

The results in this report are based only on those visitor groups interviewed that were visiting for the TT.

3 SURVEY RESULTS

It should be noted that all results in the following tables are based on those people interviewed during the survey period who in response to the question regarding 'What they had done on their visit to the Island?' answered – *Motorsport TT/MGP*, therefore this may not fully reflect the total number of people attending the TT.

Figure 1: Distribution of interviews of TT visitors during interview period – year on year comparison


